Criteria used for inclusion in CBP Measure

Two Hypertension Diagnoses

- Both diagnoses need to happen in the prior measurement year or by June 30 of the current measurement year.
- This allows 6 months' time to make lifestyle and/or medication changes to lower blood pressure (BP).
- Hypertension is defined as BP $\geq 140/90$

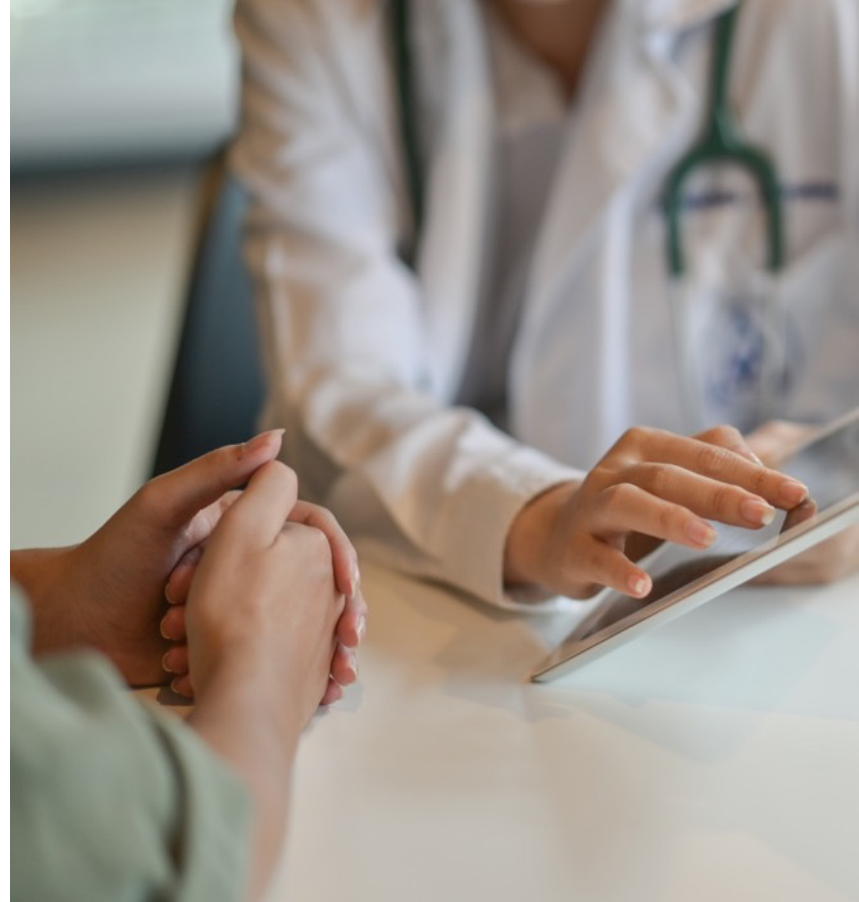


The only way we capture BP readings for QPP payments is through data feeds and CPT II codes.

CPT II code	BP reading
Systolic	
3074F	Systolic less than 130
3075F	Systolic 130-139
3077F	Systolic equal to or greater than 140
Diastolic	
3078F	Diastolic less than 80
3079F	Diastolic 80-89
3080F	Diastolic equal to or greater than 90

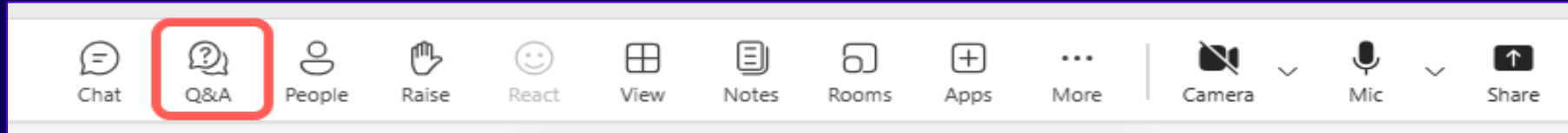
Our requests for BP gathering

- Allow patient to sit quietly for a few minutes before taking BP.
- Do a repeat BP if $\geq 140/90$.
- Document any Repeat BP's where they can be captured for QPP payment.
- Use CPT II codes for BP in visit claims.
- Document patient reported BP's where they can be captured for QPP payment.
